ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

INDIAN CREEK CONDONINIUM ASSOCIATION

The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under Section 1702.0) et seq. of the Revised Code of Ohio, do hereby certify:

FIRST: The name of said corporation shall be INDIAN GREEK CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION.

SECOND: The place in Ohio where the principal office of the corporation is to be located in Bayton, Montgomery County.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which this corporation is formed arc:

- (a) To function as the "Unit Owners Association" as provided in the Declaration creating and establishing a plan for condominium awarrahip for Indian Creek Garden Condominiums, lorated in West Carrollton, Montgomery County, Ohio, said property being submitted to the provisions of Chapter 5311 of the Revised Code of Ohio.
- (b) To exercise all of the powers and privileges and to perform all of the duties and obligations of the Association as set forth in the Declaration to establish Indian Creek Garden Condominiums.
- (c) To fix, levy and collect all charges or assessments as provided by said Declaration, to pay all expenses and costs incident to its conduct of business as the Unit Owners Association for said condominium.
- (d) To nequire (by gift, purchase or otherwise) own, hold, improve, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease transfer, dedicate for public use of real rad personal property in connection with the affairs of the condominium
- (e) To borrow money, mertgage, pledge, hypothecate or otherwise to encomber any of its resi or personal property as permitted by the Derlaration or by the members of this corporation.
- (f) To participate in mergers and consolidations provided that such action is approved by the membership and is consistent with the purposes of the condomicium as outlined in the Declaration.

- (g) To do any other thing necessary, expedient, incidental, appropriate, or convenient to the carrying out

(i) The foregoing shall be construed both as objects and powers, and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers conferred on the corporation by the laws of the State of Chic.

Except as atherwise provided by law or herein. all FOURTH: of the authority of the curporation shall be exercised by the Trustment who shall be five (5) in number and expanded to six (6) in number should a mortgagee exercise the rights to designate a representative on the Board. The following persons shall initially serve as Trustees and shall continue to serve until replaced by the action of the membership.

The other Trustses shall be elected at the first meeting of the membership.

The members of this corporation, at any time, shall be every person or entity who is a record owner of a fee interest in any Unit of Indian Creek Carden Condominiums, but excluding auch persons or entities holding any interest merely as a security for the performante of an obligation. Membership is an appurtenant to said ownership and may not be separated from ownership of any Unit.

This enropration must act as the Unit Owners Association for any amendment of the Declaration of Indian Creek Garden Condominiums, which incorporates additional land and buildings therein.

This corporation shall exist perpetually, unless SEVENTHI dissulved by the affirmative vote of at least seventy five percent (75%) of the voting power of this corporation, provided, however, such dissolution may not take place unless and until the real estate described in the Declaration of Indian Creek Garden Condominiums has been removed from the provisions of the Condominius Law.

These Acticles of Incorporation may be smended upon the approval of at least seventy live percent (75%) of the voting power of the membership.

NINTH:

Any Trustee or officer of the Curporation shall not be disqualified by his office or position from dealing or contracting with the corporation as a vendor, purchaser, employee, contracted agent or otherwise; nor shall any transaction, tontract or act of the corporation be void or voidable by reason of the fact that any Trustee voted or otherwise participated in the decision in which he has an interest, whether or not the other Trustees, officers or members of this corporation know of his interest, unless the concealment would be tentameunt to a fraud on the torporation or be illegal. Such interested Trustee shill be counted in determining the existence of a quorum and he may vote or otherwise authorize such action.
